The Revelation of God

After considering the importance and inspiration of the Bible, we began last week looking at getting to know God. The first thing we saw was how people assume that they are respecting God when in reality, they are just giving Him lip service. Once God has our attention, we will see that He is not just some far off idea or concept. We can have a relationship with Him and truly get to know Him.

So many prophets or teachers have tried to figure out how to know God. Looking at just ten of the most popular religions, 9.5 out of 10 taught that you can know God by their rituals and disciplined living. I say 9.5 because one of the 10 was Christianity and not all who claim to be Christian get it right.

In Psalm 19, David wrote about the three ways that people try to know God. The first way, in the Psalm, is very natural as so many people are satisfied with knowing God merely through some romantic perception of His creation, although that helps. The second is through His Word revealed to us, which is the absolute way. The third way is through logic, but that can be tricky, though.

1. Be careful not to presume -

Let's look at the third way first. Logic is good, when it is rightly used. It depends on using assumptions and making conclusions based on those assumptions. If you create false assumptions to build on, you will get in trouble. David speaks of *pre*sumptions in Psalm 19:12-13.

Ps 19:12-13 Who can understand *his* errors? cleanse thou me from secret *faults*.

13 Keep back thy servant also from presumptuous *sins*; let them not have dominion over me: then shall I be upright, and I shall be innocent from the great

transgression.

Presumptions are when you use unjustified assumptions about God and then use contorted logic to make it look like one is right. The more Bible you have studied, your logic about God will be more correct because it is grounded in God's Word. You won't be making speculative and outlandish assumptions about God.

H. G. Wells was never particularly religious, but after he had studied the history of the human race and had observed human life, he came to an interesting conclusion "Religion is the first thing and the last thing, and until a man has found God and been found by God, he begins at no beginning, he works to no end. He may have his friendships, his partial loyalties, his scraps of honor. But all these things fall into place and life falls into place only with God."

— Source unknown

2. Knowing God in natural revelation -

The first way of knowing God is in Psalm 19:1-6. It covers how we know *about* God as demonstrated through nature. This is called *natural revelation*. Natural revelation shows us that God *must* be real. Natural revelation shows us that there *must* be a God.

Ps 19:1-6 The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork.

²Day unto day uttereth speech, and night unto night sheweth knowledge.

³There is no speech nor language, where their voice is not heard.

⁴Their line is gone out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world. In them hath he set a tabernacle for the sun,

⁵Which is as a bridegroom coming out of his chamber, and rejoiceth as a strong man to run a race.

⁶His going forth is from the end of the heaven, and his circuit unto the ends of it: and there is nothing hid from the heat thereof.

This is confirmed in Rom 1.

Rom 1:18-21 For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness; ¹⁹Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath shewed it unto them.

²⁰For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse:

²¹Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.

Most specifically, we know His power and Godhead.

We can see through His handiwork in us how important we must be to Him:

Ps 139:12-18 Yea, the darkness hideth not from thee; but the night shineth as the day: the darkness and the light are both alike to thee.

¹³For thou hast possessed my reins: thou hast covered me in my mother's womb.

¹⁴I will praise thee; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made: marvellous are thy works; and that my soul knoweth right well. ¹⁵My substance was not hid from

thee, when I was made in secret, and curiously wrought in the lowest parts of the earth.

¹⁶Thine eyes did see my substance, yet being unperfect; and in thy book all my members were written, which in continuance were fashioned, when as yet there was none of them

¹⁷How precious also are thy thoughts unto me, O God! how great is the sum of them!

¹⁸If I should count them, they are more in number than the sand: when I awake, I am still with thee.

Looking at the hand of baby, so perfectly formed, so perfectly delicate, and so humanly functional we see His care for us. We could endlessly talk about the *great* sum of God's thoughts towards us. The great sum when we get a true perception of how great God's creation is.

Our closest relative in the "animal" world is, according to evolutionists, a chimpanzee. Evolutionists love to point out that they are practically human (or we are practically chimpanzees) because the genetic material in each is 99% the same. Then, when you dig deeper, you find out that that little percentage ends up amounting to 450,000,000 differences. False science tries to minimize that 450 million as just 1%, but they never can explain how "precious also are God's thoughts unto me...how great is the sum of them!" If they can get you to doubt just 1% then they are on their way to minimize and then eliminate God from all His creation.

- First, they never explain where the DNA came from.
- Second, you can't just throw DNA in willy nilly like paint in a blender and pour out a Mona Lisa. All sequences of DNA have to be exactly right.
- Third, there is so much DNA that

works together for each kind of biological structure that you can't just have it build up over time and then one day say, "Wow! A perfectly formed and intricately functioning thyroid gland which is also known as the orchestra leader for the entire body!" If that little gland is missing in part of its function, your whole body is affected.

In reality, people are all too happy to base their lack of faith on doubts ungodly science throws at them. Imagine if all of life was based on doubt. People would avoid life because it *might* rain, or the car *might* break down, or *maybe* lightning *might* strike. Their horoscope tells them not to leave the house, so they don't. It's like the man who heard that most accidents happened within a few miles of home. He dealt with *his* fears by moving to the other side of town. Paul warned Timothy about this even back in *his* day

1 Tim 6:20-21 O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane and vain babblings, and oppositions of science falsely so called:

²¹Which some professing have erred concerning the faith. Grace be with thee. Amen.

Don't try to be professing vain babblings and oppositions of the faith and then falsely call it science. The Greek word for science falsely so called is *pseudoscience*, or pseudo-knowledge. False science, or lying science. All the way back in the apostle Paul's day, the Epicurean philosophers believed in an atheistic evolution while the Stoics believed God was part of nature and evolution unfolded naturally. Henry Morris further described the history of the pseudo-science of evolutionism before and since the days of Paul.

It soon would take the form of Gnosticism and later of NeoPlatonism, both also assuming evolution. In other parts of the world, it had the form of Taoism, Hinduism, Confucianism or Buddhism, all based on some form of pantheistic evolution and an infinitely old cosmos. In recent times it assumed the form of Darwinism, though men are now returning again to various forms of eastern religion and their systems of pantheistic evolution, still rejecting God as Creator and Christ as Savior.

You cannot just go tip-toeing through the tulips of an evolutionary world. Now here is the point so far, there is a power in the revelation of God through nature. While we can know God by His acts and that there *must be a god*, we do need more. Knowing what He thinks requires direct revelation from Him. People will get bogged down in the science and debate the interpretation of data, but I hope that I have at least demonstrated that what we need is to hear directly from God.

Knowing God through specific revelation -

In Psalm 19:1-6 it certainly does say that the glory of God is manifest in His handiwork. It is only a start to know God through His creation. It's true that we can see the glory of God in His handiwork, but how much better it would be to know Him by His whispering in our ear, "You're doing the right thing, I'm glorified in you, keep going, I'm with you." The next part of the Psalm presents the second way of knowing God which comes by knowing Him through His Word. There are five ways David refers to the revealed Word of God in verse 7-11.

Ps 19:7-11 The law of the Lord [**The Bible**] is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the

Lord [The Bible] is sure, making wise the simple.

⁸The statutes of the Lord [**The Bible**] are right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of the Lord [**The Bible**] is pure, enlightening the eyes.

⁹The fear of the Lord is clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the Lord [**The Bible**] are true and righteous altogether.

¹⁰More to be desired are they than gold, yea, than much fine gold: sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb.

¹¹Moreover by them is thy servant warned: and in keeping of them there is great reward.

People are too lazy to know God in the ways that He wants to be known. He has given us His revealed Word, but we don't make enough of it. If you want to know God, let Him tell you Himself what He is like and what He wants and how He loves you. Don't just say, "He must be powerful and He must love me, why just look at that sunset." You must also hear the message, "God is just and holy and cannot tolerate sin and He won't overlook it, He must have it paid for, He sent His Son to die for me." You won't get that by sunsets or counting genetic differences in chimp and human DNA.

How can we know God? By His Word:

Exod 34:6 And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth,

Isa 40:28 Hast thou not known? hast thou not heard, *that* the everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth, fainteth not, neither is weary? *there is* no searching of his understanding. [His wisdom is

beyond understanding.]

Ps 103:8-13 The LORD *is* merciful and gracious, **slow to anger**, and plenteous in mercy.

- 9 **He will not always chide**: neither will he keep *his anger* for ever.
- 10 He hath not dealt with us after our sins; nor rewarded us according to our iniquities. [He gives us less than we deserve for our sins.]
- 11 For as the heaven is high above the earth, so great is his mercy toward them that fear him.
- 12 As far as the east is from the west, so far hath he removed our transgressions from us.
- 13 Like as a father pitieth *his* children, *so* the LORD pitieth them that fear him.

1John 4:8 He that loveth not knoweth not God; for **God is love**.

Num 23:19 **God** *is* **not** a **man**, **that he should lie**; neither the son of man, that **he should repent:** hath he said, and shall he not do *it*? or hath he spoken, and shall he not make it good?

Lam 3:22-23 It is of the LORD'S mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not.

23 *They are* new every morning: **great** *is* **thy faithfulness.**

4. Knowing God through the way He works in His people -

We also know what God is like through His works in the way He has dealt with mankind and especially Israel. For the sake of time, let us look at one passage. Isa 1:13-15 Bring no more vain oblations; incense is an abomination unto me; the new moons and sabbaths, the calling of assemblies, I cannot away with; *it is* iniquity, even the solemn meeting.

14 Your new moons and your appointed feasts my soul hateth: they are a trouble unto me; I am weary to bear *them*.

15 And when ye spread forth your hands, I will hide mine eyes from you: yea, when ye make many prayers, I will not hear: your hands are full of blood.

Here, Isaiah is in the middle of a diatribe against Israel for their attitude. For Israel, they are kept by God, not to be destroyed. If they did not keep their feasts, they would have been at their worst for not maintaining their identity. However, God requires more than that of them. For Israel to be at their truest, they were not only required to keep their feasts, but to do it with the right attitude. What God was expecting, while they kept their feasts, was a true heart. This is just one interaction of thousands that are recorded in God's Word.

There is just one other of the many ways to know God in His Word. God is known by His names. Although Yahweh (spelled YHWH and pronounced in English as Jehovah) is listed as His name and meaning I AM, it is combined with other words to reveal His character. There are also other descriptive names for God used in combination. There is a handout with His names available online.

We know God by the way He works in us. This one is not actually by the inspiration of revelation in the Bible, but it is very real as He works in our hearts. Unfortunately, being imperfect, we might read our feelings as if it is God's revelation. Overtime, we are able to personally glean from how God is working through us.

Ps 48:14 For this God *is* our God for ever and ever: he will be our guide *even* unto death.

What God Does:

- 1. God is always at work around you.
- 2. God pursues a continuing love relationship with you that is real and personal.
- 3. God invites you to become involved with Him in His work.
- 4. God speaks by the Holy Spirit through the Bible, prayer, circumstances, and the church to reveal Himself, His purposes, and His ways.
- 5. God's invitation for you to work with Him always leads you to a crisis of belief that requires faith and action.
 6. You must make major adjustments in your life
- adjustments in your life to join God in what He is doing.
- 7. You come to know God by experience as you obey Him and as He accomplishes His work through you.

1John 5:20 And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, even in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life.

John 10:27-28 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:

28And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them

out of my hand.

As Joe pointed out in a message recently about Genesis, you don't see some circular philosophical argument made to justify the assumption that God exists. In Genesis, you just get to see God at work. It's through the evidence provided in the Bible that you can prove God. It is through His acts that we get to know Him. It is through His testimony that we get to see something of how He thinks. It is through His instruction that we get to see what His will is.

Concerning the last days, Peter pointed out God's will and love for us:

2Pet 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

It is not surprising that you know that God exists, but you can do this without actually knowing Him. You can know only know God truly by knowing His Son as your Savior. Have you turned to Him and confessed that you are a sinner and need Him to forgive you forever and come into and join your heart to His? You can do this, not by blind faith, but through faith in His Word that He said He would do this. After this, you can grow in His Word and deepen knowing Him through His Word and His work in your life. When you know Him through your work, your knowledge will not be just academic...it will be through a personal relationship with Christ.
